#### **SUN SAFETY!!**

We think that our children only need sun protection when they're at the pool or beach but the truth is children need sun protection whenever they are outside. Here are few helpful tips to protect your family from harmful UV rays!

**Seek shade.** UV rays are strongest and most harmful between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. Try to reduce outside activities. If you are unable to do so, seek shade under a tree, umbrella or tent.





**Cover up.** Long-sleeved shirts, long pants, and skirts provide protection from UV rays, although it's not always possible! Clothing made from tightly woven fabric provide the best protection. You can find some clothing with an ultraviolet protection factor.

**Get a hat.** Hats are great for providing shade to the face, scalp, ears, and neck and provide terrific protection.





**Wear sunglasses.** Sunglasses protect your child's eyes from UV rays. Choose sunglasses that block close to 100% of both UVA and UVB rays, if possible.

**Apply sunscreen.** Choose a sunscreen with at least SPF 15 and UVA and UVB (broad spectrum) protection every time your child goes outside. For the best protection, apply sunscreen generously 30 minutes before going outdoors.

If you do not have computer access at this time and need assistance in applying for child care scholarships, please call 1-866-243-8796 and request an application.

#### To be eligible for the CCS Program, you must be:

- A Maryland resident who is working/employed, in an approved training program or attending school. For families where both parents live within the same household, both parents must meet all eligibility requirements.
- A recipient of Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA) or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or within CCS income guidelines (see below).
- Willing to have your child immunized to <u>Maryland state standards</u> or provide documentationsupporting Exemption from Immunization.
- Pursuing child support, if both parents do not live within the same household composition.
- Willing to provide proof that each child needing child care is a citizen of the United States or a qualified alien. (Provide a Birth Certificate for each child or documentation that certifies the child's status.) NOTE: Parents **ARE NOT** required to be citizens of the United States.
- Willing to provide proof of identity for all members within the household composition. (Proof of identity for the parent can be any form of a government issued document. The birth certificate or immigration status documentation can serve as proof of identity for each child in the household composition.)
- Willing to provide a Photo I.D. (Only required of the head of households.)
- An individual who is younger than 13 years old who is not disabled, or an individual younger than 19 years old who is disabled.
