



If you do not have computer access at this time and need assistance in applying for child care scholarships, please call 1-866-243-8796 and request an application.

To be eligible for the CCS Program, you must be:

- A Maryland resident who is working/employed, in an approved training program or attending school. For families where both parents live within the same household, both parents must meet all eligibility requirements.
- A recipient of Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA) or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or within CCS income guidelines (see below).
- Willing to have your child immunized to <u>Maryland state standards</u> or provide documentation supporting Exemption from Immunization.
- Pursuing child support, if both parents do not live within the same household composition.
- Willing to provide proof that each child needing child care is a citizen of the United States or a
 qualified alien. (Provide a Birth Certificate for each child or documentation that certifies the child's
 status.) NOTE: Parents ARE NOT required to be citizens of the United States.
- Willing to provide proof of identity for all members within the household composition. (Proof of
 identity for the parent can be any form of a government issued document. The birth certificate or
 immigration status documentation can serve as proof of identity for each child in the household
 composition.)
- Willing to provide a Photo I.D. (Only required of the head of households.)
- An individual who is younger than 13 years old who is not disabled, or an individual younger than 19 years old who is disabled.
