## WICOMICO PUBLIC LIBRARIES

Wicomico Public Libraries' locations currently have reduced hours to allow extra time for disinfection and cleaning spaces each day. Hours for the branches are as follows:

Centre Branch: Tuesday – Saturday, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Downtown Branch: Tuesday – Saturday, 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Pittsville Branch: Tuesday – Saturday, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

At this time, we are closed on Sundays

Library patrons and staff over the age of five are required to wear face coverings that cover the nose and mouth. For those who do not have a face covering, one will be provided. To ensure that as many patrons as possible may use the Library, each visitor is limited to a maximum visit of 45 minutes. Customers who have scheduled an appointment will have priority access to the building. Walk in appointments may be available first come first serve. Customers who do not have an appointment will be asked to wait in line outside the building until we have space for additional customers. While in line, please follow physical distancing guidelines and keep at least six feet between you and other patrons. The staff member stationed at the library's entrance will schedule you for the next available appointment. Our material collection is not available for browsing at this time.
